

[The annual meeting of the Town of Holland was held Tuesday April 18, 2017 at 7pm.](#)

Chmn Wall called the meeting to order, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the last annual meeting were read, a motion to approve them was made by Butch Jeske, seconded by Chris Biese. Motion passed.

Old Business - none

The Chmn gave the bids on stone as follows:

Gravel \$6.25/yard

Screenings \$4.45/yard

Clear stone \$11/yard

Joan Klister questioned the amount in the quotes, stating that maybe J & E Construction should be asked for a bid.

Emergency request to borrow money. A motion by Bob Rotzenberg to give the board the authority to borrow \$100,000 if the need arose, seconded by Matt Verbeten. Motion passed.

Bridge Fund: The Chmn asked that \$24,000 be put into the bridge fund, as there are 2 big culverts that are deteriorating. A motion by Bob Rotzenberg to put \$24,000 into the bridge fund, seconded by Butch Jeske. Motion passed.

A question regarding culverts was asked by Joan Klister as to why culverts were furnished by the town? Chmn Wall explained it has been the practice to furnish 1 new culvert per new homeowner's site and as for farmers if needed a pipe to a 40-acre field. Ms. Klister questioned if that money could be saved for a new town hall? The Chmn stated that this is a single installation and after that are at the owner's expense. Also, if it is a \$150,000 or a \$200,000 the town's cost is paid back in a short time.

Landfill: Sup. Geiger informed the people regarding the landfill and we were not informed of the meeting last year. He also stated that the opening could be postponed another 5 years if the new cell in Outagamie County came through. But he would have more information after the June stakeholder's meeting. Ms. Klister stated there should be more information on the town website.

Being no other business, a motion to adjourn was made by Joan Klister, seconded by Chris Biese. Meeting adjourned.
