

The Town Board of Holland met at VanAbel's on January 7, 2019 at 8:20pm. Chmn Wall called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Minutes of the last meeting were online and not read.

Next, Aaron Schmidt's C.S.M. Sup. Geiger made the motion to accept the C.S.M. of 2.93 acres of parcel HL 76, seconded by Sup. VandeWettering. Motion passed.

Then a motion by Sup. Geiger to change the zoning of that parcel 2.93 acres from exclusive ag to ag residential. The reason given are as follows: it does not effect the surrounding exclusive ag area, complies with the comp plan and is suited to be rezoned and no one objected at the hearing.
