

Town of Holland

March 2016 Minutes

The Town Board of Holland met Monday March 7 at 8pm.

All members were present. Chmn Wall called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the last meeting were read. A motion to approve them was made by Sup. Geiger, seconded by Sup. VandeWettering.

Motion passed.

There was no old business.

Open Forum: Ed Born asked if there could be some shouldering down on the town's portion of ManCal Road and the centerline be marked more clearly. The board stated that it would be looked at in spring. Mr. Born asked if the town's portions of the proposed landfill could be raised or renegotiated? The board stated that if this was done that all items of the agreement could be opened and the town would be at a disadvantage.

New Business:

Hollandtown Volunteer Fire Department contract

Sup. Geiger stated that he'd met with the department and the proposal is as follows: 3 years at \$80,000, 2 years at \$90,000 and to be looked at in 5 years and renegotiated or go strictly on a 1% valuation.

Town of Holland Atty Jim Sickel was unable to attend the board meeting and it was suggested to have him look at the document and give his okay. Sup. VandeWettering asked that this be put on the April agenda, seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed.

Board of Review annual meeting

Set May 12 for the Board of Review with a motion by Sup. VandeWettering, seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed.

County Maintenance Contract

After review, a motion to approve was made by Chmn Wall, seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed.

Comprehensive Plan

After much discussion, it was decided to postpone until 2017 when funds could be possibly available, a motion to that effect was made by Sup. VandeWettering and seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed.

Sup. VandeWettering made the motion to set April 19 at 7pm for annual town meeting, seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed.

Next, Treasurer Gloria Kennedy presented the annual report to the board for review. She asked that the members check for any items that they had questions on, then call her for clarity on any item. She further stated if they had no questions, she would go ahead and have it printed.

Being no other business, a motion to adjourn was made by Sup. VandeWettering and seconded by Sup. Geiger. Meeting adjourned.
