

The Town Board of Holland met Monday March 4, 2019 at 8pm at Van Abel's.

Chmn Wall called the meeting to order, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the February meeting were read. Motion by Sup. Geiger was made to approve them, seconded by Sup. VandeWettering. Motion passed.

Old Business: Sup. VandeWettering made the motion to review the process of how conditional use permits are issued, seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed.

Open Forum: Sup. Geiger expressed his disappointment re: how the Brown County solid waste department had failed to properly notify the LMC after they were told that Sup. Geiger would be on vacation in February. Also, Sup. Geiger's alternate was at work and unable to leave. Sup. Geiger suggested that the meeting be held in the evening or at the town hall. Atty Sickel stated the county didn't get the message to the LMC. The board asked Atty Sickel to write a letter to Mr. Haen of Solid Waste regarding future meetings.
