Town of Holland Minutes

The Town Board of Holland met on April 4, 2016 at 8pm.

All members were present and Chmn Wall called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the minutes of the last meeting were read, a motion to approve them was made by Sup. VandeWettering and seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion Passed.

There was no old business.

Open Forum: Ed Born asked re: the status of Man-Cal Road. Chmn Wall stated that he contacted the county and they would take care of painting the centerlines.

Next Item: Parcel 489 and 424 would come before the Planning Board for rezoning.

Next Item: Atty Sickel will check out the Hollandtown Volunteer Fire Dept. contract and the board is in agreement with the terms.
