

he Town Board of Holland met at 8pm on April 1, 2019 at Van Abel's following the planning board meeting.

Chmn Wall called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Minutes of the last meeting were read. A motion by Sup. Geiger to approve the minutes, seconded by Sup. VandeWettering. Motion approved.

Old Business: The board suggested that the planning board review the town ordinances at the town hall on April 8.

Open Forum: Matt Verbeten suggested that there should be more dollars from the digesters to the town.

Atty Sickel stated that they can't be taxed but a payment in lieu of taxes would be the only way dollars could be collected.

New Business: Joan and Mark Klister appeared before the board requesting the procedure to tear down the house on HL 23-2 and build a new one. Atty Sickel stated it would have to be rezoned ag residential as it is in Farmland Preservation. He suggested filling out the rezoning application and having the planning board act on the application.

Next, Sup. Geiger stated that the B.C. Solid Waste people would meet with the town board at the regular June 3 meeting at 7pm. Chmn Wall stated that the flooding and road damage would be covered by the emergency the governor has declared.

Next, the board stated the annual meeting would start at 7pm on Tuesday April 16, 2019.

Treasurer Kennedy informed the board that the country treasurer's contract is the same as last year and she would go ahead and sign the necessary document. Also, the damage to the ballpark fence has not been paid by the contractor. The board suggested that another letter be sent and if they don't respond have Atty Sickel take action. Kennedy also stated that she would send out a newsletter with all the information to the town residents.

After review of bills, a motion to pay them was made by Sup. VandeWettering, seconded by Sup. Geiger.

Any other business: Chmn Wall stated the cooler at the ballpark needs the outside sheeting to be replaced and reinsulated.

Being no other business a motion to adjourn was made by Sup. VandeWettering, seconded by Sup. Geiger.
