

November Meeting

The Town Board of Holland met on Monday November 13, 2017 at 8pm at the town hall, all members were present.

Chmn Wall called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the last meeting of the planning board and the town board were read. A motion to approve them was made by Sup. VandeWettering, seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed.

Old Business: Gloria Kennedy stated that she didn't have sufficient time to look for a printer, but will do so by this year's end.

New Business: Mark Kiel stated that things are going well with the pickup of the grass and yard waste. There has been one and up to two tons of waste collected. He has locked the dumpsters and opens them only when he is there. He further stated, it would be helpful to have them open for 9 times next year. The board thanked Mr. Kiel for his work. Also, Mr. Kiel stated that the 25 mph speed sign was stolen from the light pole and asked for it be replaced. Chmn Wall stated that it would be taken care of.

The memorandum of understanding: The board listened to the clerk read a letter asking for a 2-year contract renewal for the voter registration act. A motion to approve the participation in the system was made by Sup. Geiger, seconded by Sup. VandeWettering. Motion passed.

Next, Mr. Block appeared before the board to ask if parcel HL 215-3 could be split. After review by Atty Sickel it was decided it would not meet the frontage requirement.

Next, the Local Monitoring Committee Sup. Geiger stated that Atty George Marek has sent a letter to Brown County Solid Waste for an update on the opening of the landfill and any information on the digesters that they have. Sup. Geiger stated that from what information was given at the meeting only 10-15% of the manure could be processed and to get optimal results a combination of fats and household wastes have to be included.

Next, the adoption of levy and budget A motion by Sup. Geiger to adopt the levy and budget as set by the budget hearing was made, a second was given by Sup. VandeWettering. Motion passed.

Next, Payment of Bills After review of the bills, a motion to pay them was made by Sup. Geiger, seconded by Sup. VandeWettering. Motion passed.

Being no other business a motion to adjourn was made by Sup. Geiger, seconded by Sup. VandeWettering. Meeting adjourned.
