

Town of Holland
Comprehensive Plan meeting

At 7:30pm on October 1, 2018 the hearing of the updated Town Board of Holland comprehensive plan was reviewed. Dan Teeters from Brown County Planning presented the draft of the document.

Bob Rotzenberg questioned if the 35 acre rule was still in effect and the change to the dump site was back to ag land.

Another person asked if there were many changes from the last plan?

Dan Teeters replied that the focus was to keep the ag feature as is and that most of the development would be in the sanitary district.

It was stressed that if there were changes by the public they could be incorporated in the final document. He stated that they should direct them to his office and he would give them to the town board to consider. The next thing to be done would be to have the town planning board to meet on November 12 at 8pm and give their recommendation for the resolution of adoption. The planning board meeting was given an approval of the updated plans and a motion to tentatively approve them was made by Ray Haen, seconded by Butch Jeske. Motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned by a motion from Mike Geiger, seconded by Pete Colwell, Meeting adjourned.
