

Town of Holland Planning Board Minutes  
October 2017

The Town Board of Holland Planning Board met Monday October 2, 2017 at 7:30pm.

All members were present. Chmn Rotzenberg called the meeting to order, the item on the agenda was a request for a variance to exceed the town's limit for proximity to the neighbor's property line. The request is to permit the building of a warming house and a zamboni shed to be built at the Hollandtown Ice Rink.

The shed would encroach on the Holland Sanitary District property. A letter was received from the Sanitary District stating that they did not have a problem granting the variance to the Hollandtown Athletic Association. This building would be erected close to the Sanitary District property lines on Katie Lane.

Chmn Rotzenberg asked if there were any questions, several people in the audience spoke in favor. It would be heated with LP gas and the building would be secure. Lights are on a timer and shut off at 11pm. It was stated that all parks close at 10pm. The Hollandtown Athletic Association would be asked to

handle all of the operations of the ice rink. Chmn called for action on the variance, Mike Geiger made the motion to approve the variance, seconded by Butch Jeske. Motion passed. Being no other business, a motion to adjourn was made by Doug Verbeten and seconded by Mike Geiger. Meeting adjourned.
